POLICY

Bethel University's School of Education will embed practice PRAXIS examinations in courses designated by the program directors. Students will complete three (3) practice examinations and the PRAXIS examination during the courses approved by the faculty of the School of Education at the beginning of each academic year. The practice PRAXIS examinations must be included the evaluation of students and be included in the calculation of the final grade of students.
