Offices Held: In 1966 joined staff of denominational Board of Missions as Director of Education for Mission. As such, his primary responsibility was Editor of the Missionary Messenger which was established in 1933. He also played an important role in fundraising for the Board of Missions. In addition, Dudley served as Interim Director of Women's Work (ministry) until the position was filled, the only man to ever serve in that capacity.

Information provided by the donor: After his retirement in 1990, Dudley began painting, and at age 70 he received his Fine Arts degree from the University of Memphis. He became a prolific painter and presented one-man exhibits at the Circuit Playhouse, Theater Memphis, Randolph Galleries, and several other venues. One of his paintings, "Rivertown," appeared as the cover for the 2013 Memphis City Guide published by Memphis Magazine.
