
Dr. Thomas H. Campbell

Ordination Date: April 14, 1927

Churches Served: Campbell served as President and Dean and served seven years as pastor of the Harrison, AR, Church. He arrived at Bethel in 1943 and served Bethel College and the C. P. Theological Seminary/Memphis Theological Seminary for 29 years, 1943-72.

Offices Held: He was elected Moderator of the General Assembly in 1962.

Information provided by the donor: Campbell wrote several books relating to the history of the denomination and contributed to *A People Called Cumberland Presbyterians*, the definitive history of the church. He most recently published *Winds of Doctrine*, detailing his experience with a variety of theological movements which have influenced the church in the last sixty years.
